ARCHITECTURAL AND CULINARY PLEASURES

In the middle of the World Heritage Dolomites, at 2 096 metres above sea level, the Oberholz Alpine hut with its 360-degree terrace blends into the landscape. The contemporary architecture focuses on the mountain world through the panoramic windows and offers a cosy retreat. The hut can be reached directly from Obereggen village by the adjacent “Oberholz” chairlift. From there, a lift leads directly to the panoramic terrace, which also forms the entrance area of the hut. Via the main entrance in the south-facing glass front, one finally reaches the Oberholz Alpine hut, consisting of a restaurant, a lounge area and a bar. A small outdoor bar serves the southwest-facing panorama terrace, which is available to guests in summer and winter.
